September 13-14 • *In Honor of Shirley Englehorn*



Shirley Ruth Englehorn won a total of 11 events on the LPGA Tour, including one major championship, the LPGA Championship in 1970, in a playoff over Kathy Whitworth. Shirley led the tour that season in wins with four.

Shirley joined the LPGA Teaching Division in 1965, earning her LPGA Master Professional certification after retiring from the tour in 1979. She conducted hundreds of exhibitions nationally and internationally, was voted one of the top six teachers in America by Golf Digest in 1976 and received the LPGA National Teacher of the Year award in 1978. She was inducted into the 2014 class of the LPGA T&CP Hall of Fame.

Englehorn remains active in the golf industry as a teaching professional, most recently at the Kissing Camels Club at the Garden of the Gods Club and Resort in Colorado Springs, promoting love of the game to the next generation of young golfers. We are very fortunate to have such an esteemed member of the LPGA, like Shirley, involved with our instructional programs at Kissing Camels Club. Without a doubt, Shirley Englehorn is a great role model, humanitarian and devoted instructor to all the lives she touches and students she impacts.

## SHIRLEY CUP FORMAT

---

### CHALLENGE FORMAT

- 24 players from 18 hole group will be divided into two teams and will compete over 2 days.
- 9 Hole format – Shirley Shootout
- Tournament Pairing Party - TBD

### WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Any member of KCLGA with a current GHIN who qualifies.
- 18 hole group: The 12 lowest Gross scores and 12 lowest Net scores will be selected.
- 9 hole group TBD

### HOW DO I QUALIFY?

- Qualify any day between May 1st and August 31st
- Let the pro shop know before you go out that you are trying to qualify.
- You must putt out everything, and have a fellow player attest your score card.
- Turn in your attested score card, with your gross and net scores, to the Golf Shop immediately after your round.
- Your membership account will be charged \$25 the first time you try to qualify.

- A player may attempt to qualify as many times as she wishes within the qualifying period from either the yellow or orange tees.
- The 12 lowest Gross scores and 12 lowest Net scores from 18 hole group will qualify to participate in the tournament.

### HOW DO I KNOW I HAVE QUALIFIED?

- Results will be posted at least biweekly.

### WHAT IS THE COST?

- \$25 entry fees will be pooled to offset the food and team shirt costs of the event.
- Each qualifying participant will be charged an additional \$25 to play in the event.
